## Rio Grande Valley Metropolitan Planning Organization Annual Listing of Projects

### Introduction

Pursuant to 23 CFR 450.334, each Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) must submit an Annual Listing of Obligated Projects (APL or ALOP) within 90 calendar days following the end of the program year. The program year follows the Federal fiscal year (October 1 – September 30). Any reference to "fiscal year" in this document refers specifically to the Federal fiscal year.

As part of this process, MPOs must actively seek public input on the APL through the procedures outlined in their Public Participation Plans (PPP). This outreach follows a similar approach to the development and approval of short-range planning and programming efforts, such as the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP).

The APL includes only projects that have received Federal funding. Projects funded solely by state and/or local sources are not included. By publishing this listing, MPOs enhance transparency and ensure that the public and stakeholders have access to information about the allocation of federal transportation funds within the region.

### Discussion Key Terms and Concepts in Statutory Language

**Cooperative Process** – Federal regulation requires the MPO, State, and public transportation operator(s) to cooperate in preparing a list of projects for which federal funds were obligated for spending during the immediately preceding year. This cooperation is essential because of separate responsibilities held by organizations in planning, programming, and project implementation. The MPO presents information on the projected schedule and funding for projects listed within the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP), based only upon what is received from implementing organizations. Similarly, up to date information on implementation of projects in the TIP is available only from those implementing organizations. Thus, the annual report of projects for which an obligation of funds took place must be a cooperative effort.

**Metropolitan Area Focus** – Although the Annual Project Listing of obligated projects provision appears in both metropolitan and statewide planning sections of the law, the applicability is limited to metropolitan areas. Statutory reference is made in conjunction with statewide TIPs, but only to the extent that those

documents contain project information from metropolitan area TIPs. These two references in law are redundant and are not meant to require two separate project listings.

**Content and Format of Project Listing** – The project listings should align with categories included in the TIP. This includes project name, location, and other descriptive information included in the TIP. The listing also should include the amount of funds programmed in the TIP, the amount obligated in the program year, and the amount of funds remaining and available for use in subsequent years.

**Pedestrian and Bicycle Facilities** – The Annual Listing must include obligations for projects in the TIP that were specifically identified as bicycle or pedestrian projects. For projects in the TIP that include bicycle and/or pedestrian facilities as an incidental part of a larger project, a reasonable effort should be made to identify the cost and general location of these facilities in the Annual Listing.

**Timing of Publication** – The Annual Listing should be completed and published within three months after the end of the program year. The list should also include visual components, such as maps and charts, to ensure that the information is understandable to a broad readership with varying levels of familiarity with transportation planning and programming concepts.

**Program Year** – The year for which project obligations are reported would be each MPO’s previous program year. The program year can be a calendar year, the Federal fiscal year, the local fiscal year, or any other annual increment that MPOs and States choose for the TIP.

**Advance Construction (AC)** – Advance Construction (AC) allows states to begin a project even in the absence of sufficient Federal-aid obligation authority to cover the Federal share of project costs. Advance construction does not reduce the available apportionment of a Federal program nor the available obligation limitation. There is no guarantee or obligation by either the state or FHWA. If funds are not available, the state will not be able to convert the project to Federal funding. Projects approved for AC will not appear in the APL until the authorization has been converted to Federal funds. The date of the AC conversion, as reflected in a Project Modification, is the date that Federal funds are obligated. (see 23 CFR 630, Subpart G) <https://www.ecfr.gov/current/title-23/chapter-I/subchapter-G/part-630/subpart-G?toc=1>

**Federal Project Authorization and Agreement (FPAA) (or Project Agreement)** – This is the Federal approval document memorializing that a project has met the prerequisite Federal requirements and that the authorized scope is eligible for Federal participation. The FPAA serves as the legal instrument documenting the obligation of Federal funds and as the Authorization to Proceed. States can opt to obligate Federal funds at the time of project authorization or to use Advance Construction (AC). An FPAA must be executed before any reimbursable project costs are incurred. TxDOT will prepare and submit an FPAA to request the obligation of Federal funds after STIP approval when a project is ready to let. For local government-sponsored projects, TxDOT submits the FPAA after execution of the Advance Funding Agreement. **Fiscal Management Information System (FMIS)** – The Fiscal Management Information System (FMIS) is the Federal Highway Administration’s (FHWA) major financial information system for tracking Federal-Aid highway projects on a project-by-project basis. It contains data related to all highway projects financed with Federal-Aid Highway Grant Funding.

**Obligation** – An obligation is a legal commitment, the Federal government’s promise to pay a State for the Federal share of a project’s eligible cost. This commitment occurs when FHWA approves TxDOT’s FPAA request and uploads the FPAA into FMIS. Obligated funds are considered “used” even though no actual funds are transferred.

**Project Modification** – This is a revision to the original FPAA to change certain terms and conditions, such as increasing the amount of obligated Federal funds for authorized purposes such as letting reconciliation, changes to current cost estimates, initiation of a subsequent project phase, or conversion of AC to regular Federal financing. (23 U.S.C 106, 23 CFR 630, Subpart A)

## **Annual Listing of Projects Data Fields**

**Federal-Aid Project Number:** This is a unique project identifier created when TxDOT submits the Federal Project Authorization and Agreement (FPAA) (see definition below) request to FHWA. For preparing the APL, TxDOT retrieves this number from the Federal Fiscal Management Information System (FMIS) (see definition below). The Federal-Aid Project Number can encompass multiple CSJ Numbers. This is especially significant for Grouped Projects. Please see the Grouped Projects discussion below.

**CSJ Number:** This is a TxDOT-assigned unique project identifier for tracking and managing a project. In FMIS, this number is used as a Recipient Project Number for tracking and reporting purposes. For preparing the APL, TxDOT retrieves this number from FMIS.

**MPO Project ID:** This is a unique identifier the MPO assigns to a project for listing in the MTP and TIP. For the preparing the APL, TxDOT retrieves this number from the eSTIP Portal, except for Grouped Projects, for which the data field is left blank for the MPO to fill in. If the MPO's MTP contains an individual or blanket MPO Project ID for Grouped Project(s), the MPO should enter that MPO Project ID, otherwise the MPO should enter "N/A."

**Sponsor:** This is the name of the agency responsible for carrying out the project or phase per 23 CFR 450.326(g)(4). [https://www.ecfr.gov/current/title-23/part-450#p-450.326\(g\)\(4\)](https://www.ecfr.gov/current/title-23/part-450#p-450.326(g)(4)) For preparing the APL, TxDOT retrieves this information from the eSTIP Portal, except for Grouped Projects, for which the item will be left blank for the MPO to fill in. In many cases, such as for resurfacing projects, the Sponsor will be TxDOT.

**Phase of Work, Project Name/Facility, Limits, and Project Description:** This is the descriptive material of the project or phase per 23 CFR 450.326(g)(1). [https://www.ecfr.gov/current/title-23/part-450#p-450.326\(g\)\(1\)](https://www.ecfr.gov/current/title-23/part-450#p-450.326(g)(1)) For preparing the APL, TxDOT retrieves this information from FMIS.

**Funding Categories:** TxDOT organizes the Unified Transportation Program (UTP) into prescribed funding categories that address specific project types or ranges of eligible activities. For preparing the APL, TxDOT retrieves this information from the eSTIP Portal, except for grouped projects, for which the APL reflects "N/A."

**Amount of Federal Funding Programmed in MPO TIP:** For Highway and Bike/Ped projects, this is the amount of Federal funds programmed in the TIP in the same fiscal year as the initial FPAA. The only time you should see a dollar amount is if the APL year is the first year of the obligation of Federal funds; otherwise, this data field will show "MOD." "MOD" means that federal funds were originally obligated in a previous fiscal year and the increase in obligated Federal funds is due to a Project Modification (see definition below). If the term "MOD" is used, it is assumed that the Amount of Federal Funding Programmed in MPO TIP was reflected in a prior year APL. For preparing the APL, TxDOT retrieves this information from the eSTIP Portal, except for Grouped Projects, for which the APL reflects "Grouped-Not in TIP."

**Amount of Federal Funding Obligated in Fiscal Year:** For new projects in the APL fiscal year, this amount is reflected in the initial FPAA and any subsequent Project Modifications executed during the APL fiscal year (23 CFR 630.106). <https://www.ecfr.gov/current/title-23/section-630.106> If Federal funds were originally obligated in a prior fiscal year, this is the amount of increase in Federal funds obligated as reflected in a Project Modification (see definition below). If the project was previously approved for Advance Construction (AC) (see definition below), this is the amount obligated when the

project is converted to regular Federal financing. All or a part of the funds approved for AC, can be subsequently converted (i.e., obligated) during subsequent fiscal years. The APL is only for reporting increases in Federal obligations, not decreases.

Amount of Federal Funding Remaining and Available for Subsequent Years: In most cases, the APL will reflect “N/A” for this item. For phased projects with Federal funds obligated for PE, this is the amount of Federal funds currently programmed in the TIP for subsequent phases, i.e., ROW and/or Construction.

### **Grouped Projects**

Pursuant to 23 CFR 450.218 (j) <https://www.ecfr.gov/current/title-23/section-450.218> , at the discretion and approval of FHWA TX Division, projects that are not considered to be of appropriate scale for individual identification in a given program year may be grouped by function, work type, and/or geographic area. Since Grouped Projects are not individually listed in the TIP, the APL will never show a dollar amount for ‘Amount of Federal Funding Programmed in MPO TIP.’ Instead, this data field will reflect “Grouped-Not in the TIP.” If the CSJ Number for a Grouped Project listed in the APL is not recognized, that does not mean the project is listed in error. Many Grouped Projects encompass numerous CSJ Numbers within a single Federal-Aid Project Number. Think of each CSJ Number as a segment of a larger project that extends through multiple TxDOT districts and sometimes multiple MPOs. For Grouped Projects with multiple CSJ Numbers, FHWA requested that only the first CSJ Number listed in a report downloaded from FMIS be shown in the APL. FHWA tracks this information by Federal-Aid Project Number, not by CSJ Number. The TPP Traffic Analysis Section developed GIS layers for each Grouped Project within which TPP can identify all the affected MPOs. The project limits of one of these Grouped Projects only need to touch an MPO boundary to be included in the APL.

## **RGVMPO Background**

Federal regulation requires urbanized areas with a population greater than 50,000 to develop an MPO as a condition for spending federal highway or transit funds. The Rio Grande Valley MPO promotes a regional perspective towards transportation planning and has the responsibility for planning, programming, and coordinating federal investments. The Rio Grande Valley MPO planning process creates a partnership among state, local government, and transit operators in providing transportation improvements. The Rio Grande Valley MPO coordinates planning efforts with the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT), Lower Rio Grande Valley Development Council (LRGVDC), regional transit providers: Valley Metro, McAllen Metro & Brownsville Metro, Federal Highway Administration (FHWA), and Federal Transit Administration (FTA). The Transportation Policy Board (TPB) is the decision-making committee of the MPO. The committee develops its positions by working with the agencies previously listed, elected officials, local government staff, the and the general public, through a committee system where various issues are presented, discussed, and recommendations are made. Current committees include the Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) and Bicycle Pedestrian Advisory Committee (BPAC). Special subcommittees and working groups are created and appointed, as need dictates.
