A RESOLUTION OF THE RIO GRANDE VALLEY METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION (RGVMPO) APPOINTING MICHAEL MEDINA TO THE BORDER TRADE ADVISORY COMMITTEE (BTAC)

WHEREAS, the RGVMPO is the designated agency for transportation planning in the Transportation Management Area made up of Hidalgo County, Cameron County, and Starr County in the State of Texas; and

WHEREAS, each of the three counties within the RGVMPO region features international border crossings through a variety of mechanisms, including vehicular and pedestrian bridges, freight rail, and commercial ports of entry; and

WHEREAS, the RGVMPO recognizes the importance of regional and international coordination in advancing transportation priorities and fostering cross-border economic development; and

WHEREAS, international travel and trade are vital to the mobility, economic vitality, and strategic growth of the RGVMPO, the State of Texas, and the United States of America; and

WHEREAS, the Border Trade Advisory Committee (BTAC) provides a forum for the exchange of communications between the Texas Transportation Commission, TxDOT, the Office of the Governor, and committee members representing border trade interests, serving as a key mechanism for aligning local priorities with state and federal transportation policy; and

WHEREAS, ensuring that the RGVMPO is represented by its Executive Director on BTAC helps to advance the organization's policy objectives, promote regional needs, and support the committee's broader mission;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TRANSPORTATION POLICY BOARD OF THE RGVMPO that Michael Medina, Executive Director of RGVMPO, is hereby appointed to represent the RGVMPO on the BTAC.


